

## Public Bath Usage Rules

**Operating Hours:** 14:00–24:00 | 05:00–10:00

To ensure a comfortable and safe experience for all guests using the public bath (which refers to both the bathing area and the changing area, hereinafter referred to as the "bath"), we kindly ask that you adhere to the following rules:

1. The public bath is for hotel guests only. Non-registered guests are not permitted to use it.
2. You may use the public bath in the yukata (Japanese robe) and slippers provided in your room.
3. Smoking is prohibited inside the public bath.
4. The following individuals are requested to refrain from using the bath:
  1. Guests with tattoos. However, bathing is allowed if tattoos are covered with a designated cover seal provided by the hotel.
  2. Guests who are intoxicated or under the influence of alcohol.
  3. Guests with skin conditions.
  4. Guests with infectious diseases.
  5. Guests who are feeling unwell.
  6. Guests who violate the hotel's accommodation agreement or other hotel rules.
5. In accordance with regulations, mixed-gender bathing is not allowed for guests over the age of 7.
6. For safety reasons, children are not allowed to bathe alone. A guardian must accompany children at all times.
7. In compliance with hygiene standards, the hotel has established regulations to ensure a comfortable experience for all guests. Due to the possibility of affecting other guests' use of the facilities, we regret to inform you that children who are not yet toilet trained are not permitted to use the public bath.
8. Face towels are not provided, so please bring one from your room.
9. Please remove your shoes and slippers before entering the changing area. Also, please refrain from wearing swimsuits in the bathing area.
10. Please store your clothing, valuables, and personal belongings in

the lockers.

11. Be sure to lock your locker and take care not to lose the key. A 3,000 yen fee will be charged for key replacement if lost.
12. The hotel is not responsible for any loss or theft of valuables or personal items in the changing area.
13. The bath should be used solely for bathing purposes. Washing laundry or dyeing hair inside the bath is prohibited.
14. Please wash your body and rinse off soap or foam before entering the bath.
15. The bath may become crowded during certain times, and we ask for your understanding if this causes any inconvenience. During crowded times, we kindly ask guests to be considerate of one another to help alleviate congestion.
16. Photography and video recording are prohibited inside the public bath. Please refrain from using mobile phones, smartphones, cameras, or similar devices, as they may disturb other guests.
17. Please refrain from disruptive behavior, such as running, jumping, swimming, or making loud noises, as this can disturb other guests.
18. Please refer to any other important notices posted within the facility or the public bath area.
