Walk the Old Tokaido Trail

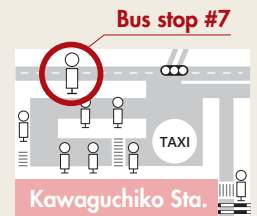
Historic stone paths and towering cedar trees take you back to Edo-era Japan.

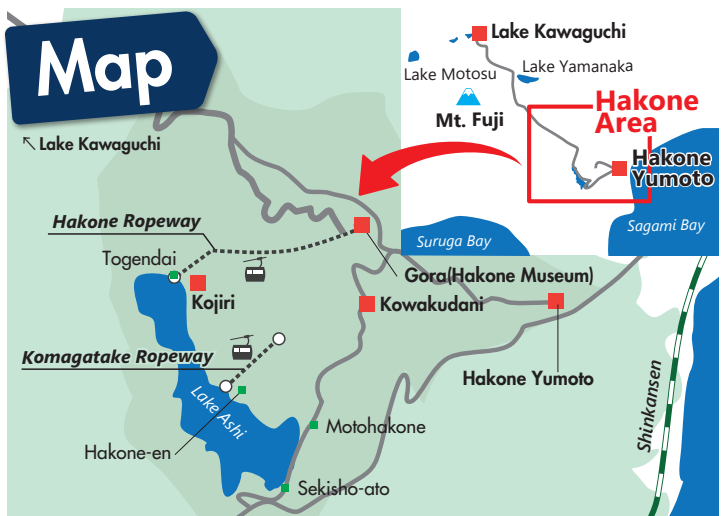
